1. A Student Affiliate member or full member of the American Chemical Society and
2. Currently enrolled in a full-time program of studies leading to a degree in chemistry, biochemistry, biotechnology, chemical engineering, or other chemically-related fields such as environmental science, materials science, or toxicology or chemical technology and
3. A US citizens or permanent residents (a photocopy of the "Green Card" with the alien registration number will be required).

All applicants must submit **two letters** of recommendation.

1. One letter should be from someone, preferably your SAACS advisor, who can provide insight into the applicant's personal character, potential, and motivation for the endeavor.
2. Students must also obtain a second letter of recommendation from a faculty member in their field of study and indicate the student's academic interests and abilities related to the endeavor.

All applicants must submit a **transcript** with grades from all colleges attended.
